Key Responsibilities:

Physical Performance

- Assist the Lead Physical Performance Coach with the delivery of physical performance services for the PFA residential rehabilitation programme.
- Conduct physical profiling for all players on the PFA residential rehabilitation programme. Feedback the information to the multidisciplinary team, the player and use the information to design and implement off-field conditioning, pitch-based conditioning and strength and conditioning programmes.
- Design and deliver off-field and pitch-based conditioning sessions relevant to the players stage of rehabilitation.
- Design and deliver strength and conditioning sessions relevant to the players stage of rehabilitation.
- Deliver hydrotherapy sessions.
- Physical exertion monitoring using GPS and heart rate technologies. Produce GPS & HR reports which will be feedback to the player and/or club.
- Establish excellent long-term working relationships with Medical and Sport Science departments who refer into the scheme to optimise player care for current and future referrals.
- Support delivery of additional P3RFORM projects/services/programmes when needed



- Provide reports on all players who access the PFA rehabilitation programme in line with P3RFORM policy.
- Programme, and coach clients virtually via P3RFORM coaching platform
- Support P3RFORM social media and PR opportunities

- · Arrange all pre & post information required for players attending the programme

- Meet players each week onsite at SGP and ensure all details around their stay is arranged
- Liaise with Triage Physio to help streamline the care pathways for clients
